Meeting Report ISO TC 188/WG 29 Amsterdam, The Netherlands November 18, 2013

Technical Committee 188 – Working Group 29, Galley stoves

1. The transitional period for introduction of new standards in ISO is requested to move from 6 to 12 months. The industry is asking for a 12 month transitional period for this standard, due to the addition of heating appliances to the scope of the standard.

ISO 14895, Liquid – fuelled galley stoves and heating appliances

- 1. Some heaters come with low voltage cut-off devices. This potential requirement will submitted to the Electrical WG for consideration for all battery-operated appliances.
- 2. A duplicate label containing manufacturer's information shall be provided by the manufacturer and installed, if needed, after appliance installation.
- 3. Added requirements for use of both permanent fuel tanks and portable fuel tanks.
- 4. Added a requirement for a flame failure device. Still need to define this device and its operational requirements.
- 5. Deleted the requirement that the appliances are room-sealed.
- 6. Next Action: Next meeting of the WG will be held at Boot Dusseldorf 2014.
